The 2017-2018 Young Adults in Global Mission (YAGM)

On Thursday afternoon, August 24th, I stood anxiously waiting at the arrivals walkway with one of my Finnish Lutheran Mission colleagues at the Dakar Airport.

We examined the baggage tags of every person who passed to see if they were on the same flight as the new YAGMs. Every couple of minutes I stood on my tiptoes to get a better glimpse of the exit door.

Finally I saw a familiar face. Then two familiar faces. And finally seven familiar faces of the new 2017-2018 Senegal YAGM! All safely arrived in Dakar to begin their sojourn in Senegal.
